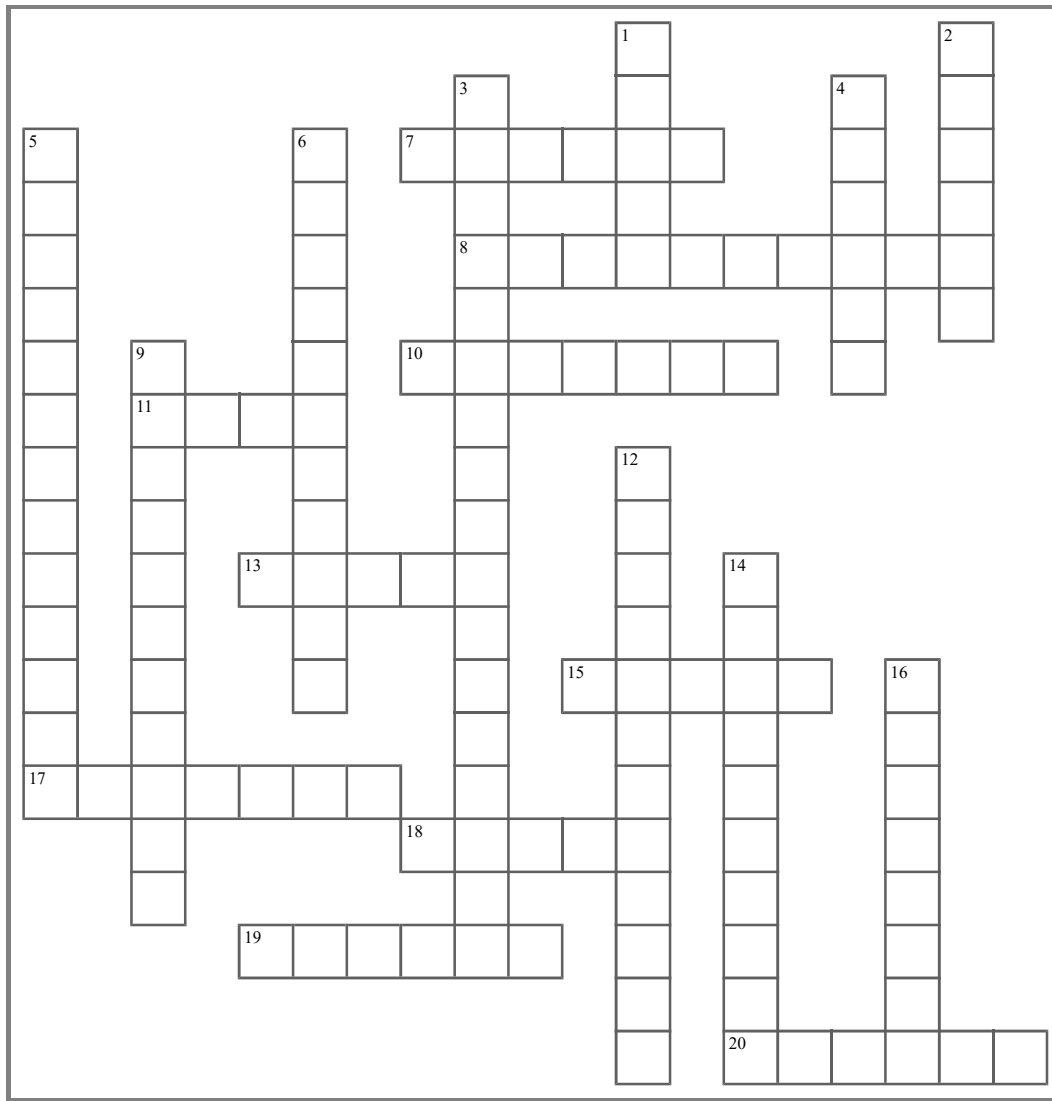


Another Twenty Things About Creuse

8. Large man-made lake in the south of the department covering almost 10km²
10. Small town with a war memorial featuring a golden cock on a dead eagle
11. Medieval bridge over the river Creuse near Felletin
13. The Dolmen d'Urbe is close to this town
15. This tower served as an observatory to the astronomer César-François Cassini
17. 5.5m tall 12th century structure for the dead in Saint Goussard
18. Herd of large herbivores that can be found at Thauron
19. 300 of these were found cremated at the La Nécropole des Sagnes
20. Commune created in 2017 by a merger of two
